Agnes Anna Kempf became "all better" as she went into the arms of Jesus on Sep. 14, 2012 at the age of 103. Born Aug. 7, 1909 in Venice Center, MI to the late Nellie (Merrill) and William Golombisky, Agnes married Lester D. Bouck in Corunna, MI and moved to Grand Ledge in 1927, having 2 children and working for the Grand Ledge Chair Co. for 6 years. She retired as a Secretary for Grand Ledge Public Schools after 18 years of which she was very proud. Being a Wife, Mother and Grandmother, she considered her greatest accomplishments. She wed Charles Conrad Kempf in 1940 and they had 2 sons and 49 years together. Agnes had a large variety of interests but especially enjoyed sewing, crocheting and knitting and her retirement for 14 years in Elk Rapids, MI. Moving back to Grand Ledge in 1989, her church, family and friends were recipients of her love and devotion. She became an active member of United Methodist Church and her Lord and Savior exemplified her life. At 100 years of age she courageously moved to Hudson, Florida to make her home with her daughter and son-in-law exhibiting her spirit of adventure and facing life head on. She is preceded in death by both husbands, sister Irene Waterous, brother Clarence Golombisky and one great grandson Wayne Eugene Bouck.
