Beverly L. Temple, age 93 of Grand Ledge, passed peacefully on June 12, 2024, at her residence in Independence Village. Beverly was born on December 18, 1930, in Detroit, MI, the daughter of Edward and Louise (Murrell) Radenberg. Beverly moved to Grand Ledge in 1966 with her family. She was employed by the Grand Ledge Public School system as a teachers aide for about eight years, then continued to work as a secretary for the State of Michigan until she retired in 1991.

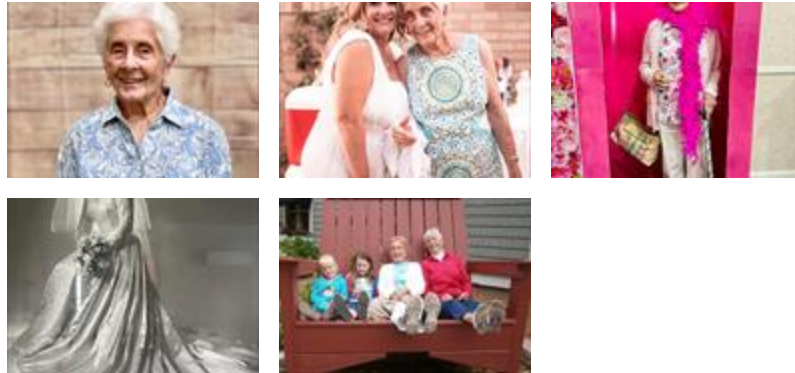
