Donald John Way, a beloved family man and friend, passed away peacefully on March 25, 2026, surrounded by his loved ones. Born on May 14, 1934, in Mulliken, Michigan to the late John R. and Madelyn (Kerstetter), he was a proud graduate of Grand Ledge High School, Class of 1952.

Following graduation Don enlisted in the U.S. Army and served in the Korean War. He was Honorably Discharged in 1955.

His entrepreneurial spirit led him to enrich the Grand Ledge business community.
