



## Edythe L. Bouck

January 1, 1922 - October 25, 2013

Edythe L. (Hiscock) Bouck was born January 1, 1922 and passed away peacefully on October 25, 2013. She was the daughter of Harold and Naomi (Wilkinson) Hiscock and was a lifelong resident of Grand Ledge and Delta Township. In 1941, she married Vene Bouck and they raised their four children: Robert (Terry) Bouck, Donald (Kaye) Bouck, William (Becky) Bouck, and Nancy (Pat) McGuirk. She started the Stitchery Guild in Grand Ledge, was the originator of the 50+ Alumni Association of Grand Ledge High School serving as chairwoman for three terms, and was a member of the Oakwood Cemetary Board for 20 years, serving as chairwoman until 2003.

She especially enjoyed attending sporting events of her children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren and her travels led her all over Michigan and the United States for their games.
