He moved to the mainland from Puerto Rico in 1956; however, his heart was always for his homeland. He married Anita, the love of his life, in 1966 and they spent 56 blessed years together. Eufrasio was a member of Rivers of Life Church in Lansing and was an Ordained Minister and also held a degree from the Dale Carnegie University. Eufrasio followed the leading of the Lord and felt compelled to share the Gospel to the lost. He wanted to make sure that he shared with those folks around him how they could be sure they were on their way to Heaven by placing their faith and trust in Jesus as their savior.
