Fred Paul Miller of Lansing; a devoted son, brother and uncle passed away December 25, 2022 after a courageous battle with cancer. Paul was born February 2, 1971 in Royal Oak, Michigan to Alan and Cecil (Pelter) Miller. He graduated from Bishop Borgess High School in Redford, Michigan Class of 1990 and attended Lansing Community College. Paul was a Community Inclusion Specialist for the Michigan Disability Rights Coalition where he worked tirelessly advocating for those who needed a voice. He worked with his colleagues to educate and inform their communities about the needs of others and how to meet those needs. Paul was a longtime active member of the Central Free Methodist Church and he will be greatly missed by his church family. He was an artist who especially enjoyed creating portraits with water colors.

He is survived by his mother, Cecil Miller; sister, Elizabeth (Jeremy) Miller-Gershfeld and nephews, Levi and Oscar. Paul was preceded in death by his father, Alan in 2019.
