Gregory "Killer" Cribley of Grand Ledge a gentle giant, a big man with a big heart passed away November 24, 2013. He will be greatly missed by all of his family and friends. Killer was the firstborn of Francis and Marge (Galvin) Cribley on May 6, 1948 in Lansing, Michigan. He was a Grand Ledge High School graduate Class of 1966 and attended Central Michigan. Killer was a retired rural letter carrier and a huge fan and supporter of Grand Ledge athletics. He coached Grand Ledge Pony Colt League and was an assistant high school baseball coach. He was also a big Tigers and Lions fan and enjoyed going up north with friends for the annual hunting trip.
