Gregory Chester Dunn, a beloved husband, father, brother, and friend, passed away peacefully at home on May 7, 2026, just days shy of his 68th birthday. Born on May 13, 1958, in Lansing, Michigan, Greg was the son of the Doss P. Dunn, Jr. and Joanne L. (Hoy) Lunn. Growing up, he made a name for himself, not just as a musician but as a genuine, kind soul whose laughter and music brought joy to many.

Many will remember him as a key member of the progressive rock and jazz band, Eye of the Storm which later became Current Conditions. Greg even was invited to perform alongside notable artists, including musical composer CJ Vanston.

Greg leaves behind his loving spouse, Tracy (Chapel) Dunn, and his cherished daughter, Amy (Karin) Ramirez. He is also survived by his brothers, Brian (Barbara Robinson-Dunn) and Kevin (Gina) Dunn; brother-in-law, Bernard F. Finn, along with several nieces and nephews. With a family so dedicated to him, he will be dearly missed by many friends and loved ones. He was preceded in death by his father, Doss P. Dunn, Jr., his mother and step-father, Joanne and Leo Lunn and sister, Jane Louise Finn.
