With heavy hearts, we announce, Harold Joseph Olds was called to his Heavenly Home December 13, 2025. Born on May 26, 1947, in Lansing, Michigan.

Harold graduated from Grand Ledge High School with the Class of 1965. He will be remembered for his athletic talents by the Grand Ledge community, fellow teammates, and coaches for his speed on the field and track. Harold was recruited by many colleges and chose Dayton where he played for George Perles and Wayne Fontes who both remembered him years later at a reunion. All State and All American, Harold was inducted into the Grand Ledge Hall of Fame in 2005 and still holds school records after 60 years in the 200 Meter.

Harold brought dedication, honesty, and integrity to his career as a supervisor at General Motors Parts Plant and successfully to his Amway business with his late wife Ann. He will truly be missed by all who worked for and with him.

Above all, Harold was a devoted family man. He is survived by his beloved family, wife Kimberly Raycraft; his son Matt (Karmin) Olds; daughter Elizabeth (Josh) Grant; and son Tony (Maggie) Olds. 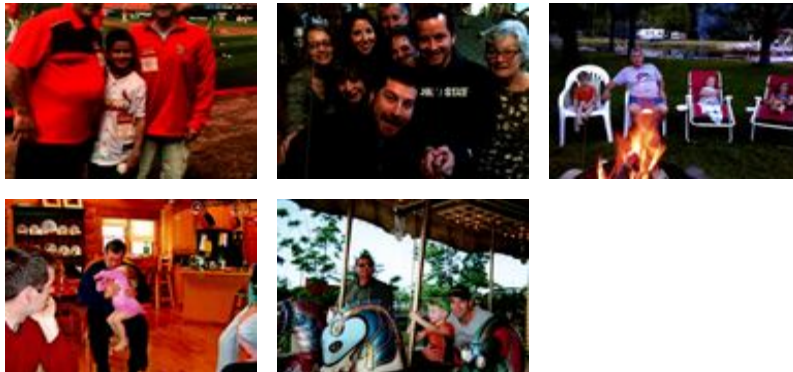
