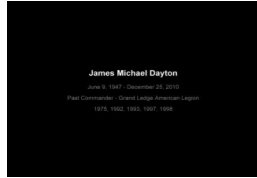
June 9, 1947 - December 25, 2010

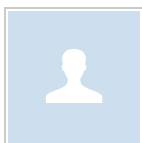
