God's garden must be beautiful for he only takes the best.

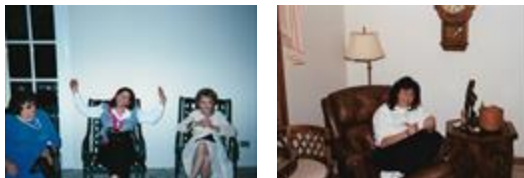
He saw the road was getting rough, and the hills were hard to climb.
