Jerry Dean Waldrop of Eagle passed away September 25, 2019 in Lansing, MI. He was born August 21, 1939 in Rockville, Indiana and raised by the late Virgil and Arizona (Floyd) Waldrop. Jerry graduated with the Grand Ledge High School Class of 1957 and went on to receive a Bachelor's Degree in Engineering from the University of Michigan. He began his career at McNamee Porter & Seely before working as a Project Manager at Clark Construction Co. for 23 years. Always a community supporter, Jerry spent many years coaching and promoting high school athletics. He volunteered for Ann Arbor Pioneer High School concessions before moving back to Grand Ledge. At Grand Ledge High School he announced freshman and JV football games, took tickets during many athletic events and was an announcer and past President of GLAYF Football. It was not uncommon to hear Jerry's enthusiastic voice booming out of the PA and down the streets Thursday nights and weekends. Jerry was also an avid golfer, woodworker and die-hard University of Michigan Football fan.
