Leopold "Leo" Wozniak of Grand Ledge formerly of Tawas City and Lansing, passed away January 17, 2015. Leo was born October 28, 1922 in Evanston, Illinois to the late John and Anna (Dzikowski) Wozniak. Leo was a WW II Navy Veteran and worked as a radio announcer at WFDF in Flint. He went on to retire from the Federal Aviation Administration, working at Lansing Capital Region International Airport. Leo enjoyed photography, writing poems and songs and loved to country line dance. He was sometimes called the "dancing cowboy". He was a member of the Tawas Kiwanis Club and served in the Coast Guard Auxiliary. He is survived by his beloved wife of over sixty-four years, Harriet (Rodgers); daughters, Kathleen (Jack Killeen) Bricker, Linda (Gregory) Wittmann, Victoria Parsons and Judith (Patrick) Siegert; 9 grandchildren and 3 great grandchildren.
