Margaret Elaine (Kempf) Morrow formerly of Grand Ledge, Michigan and Largo, Florida passed away December 1, 2019. Margaret was born January 3, 1917 in Watertown Twp., Clinton County, Michigan to the late Louis J. and Bernice B. (Forward) Kempf. She weighed just 3 pounds at birth and her father carried her around on a pillow. To keep her warm, her parents placed her in the oven. As a child she contracted scarlet fever and polio at the same time and was paralyzed for six months. As an adult she worked at Lansing Dry Cleaners and in the sewing department final finishing line at Fisher-Body. Margaret married the love of her life, Clifford Morrow, in 1951 and became a housewife and mother to Cliff's three sons; Wayne, Vernon and Seeley. She is survived by siblings Eloise Lawson, Norman (Vivian) Kempf and Robert (Matilde) Kempf; numerous nieces, nephews and step grandchildren. Margaret was preceded in death by her parents; husband; stepsons; siblings and their spouses: Charles Conrad (Agnes) Kempf, Alice (Virgil) Dolbee, Helen (Clarence) Randt, Harris (Doris) Kempf, Evelyn (James) Davis, and Roger (Connie) Kempf; brother-in-law Laurence Lawson and sister-in-law Vesta Reglin.
