Mertie M. Frost age 97 of Grand Ledge passed away August 19, 2007. Mertie was a graduate of Charlotte High School Class of 1927 and also received a bachelor degree from Western Michigan and a Masters degree from Michigan State. Mertie taught in public schools for 42 years and retired from Grand Ledge Public Schools as the principal of Holbrook Elementary. Mertie was a member of the Grand Ledge First Congregational UCC, life member of The Delta Kappa Gamma Society, Order of the Eastern Star Life and Gold member Grand Ledge #14, Pilgrim Circle, Charter member of the Michigan Reading Association and also received a Volunteer Leadership award for "outstanding volunteer service" to her community which was a statewide recognition.
