### NORMAN A. GLASSER

Age 87, died January 28, 2010 in Grand Ledge, Michigan following a brief illness. Mr. Glasser was born June 12, 1922, son of Norman E. and Leda Glasser. Norm was a life long resident of Gaylord having attended Gaylord High School where he was an outstanding football, baseball, and basketball player. Mr. Glasser was a veteran of WWII and served in the USNR for five years spending two years in the South Pacific. He returned home, married Sarah E. Schreur, graduated from Ferris College as a pharmacist, and for 20 years, Sarah and he were owners of Glasser's™ Drug Store. Mr. Glasser was an active participant in the Gaylord Community having served on numerous boards including Gaylord State Bank, The Gaylord School Board and the Historical Society. Norm was also a board member of the State of Michigan Kidney Foundation, a position he especially enjoyed as he was one of Michigan's™ longest living kidney transplant recipients, having received a kidney from his son, Norm, 40 years ago. Mr. Glasser was an avid sportsman. He enjoyed opening day of deer season with sons, brothers, and nephews. He loved golf, football, basketball, and cribbage. Mr. Glasser was preceded in death by a daughter, Susan, wife Sarah, and brothers, Clare and Robert. He is survived by his loving family: children, Norman J. (Sally), Jean A. (Joel), David P.
