Patrick Richard Dillon of Grand Ledge went to be with the Lord with his loving family by his side on December 19, 2022 after a courageous battle with cancer. Pat was born September 5, 1947 in Lansing, Michigan to the late Richard and Selma (Heim) Dillon. He graduated from Holt High School Class of 1965 and served in the United States Air Force in Europe during the Vietnam War. Pat worked as a Parts Manager at a number of car dealerships over the years and retired in 2009. He was the former President and active member of the Holt Jaycees and also elected to serve as a Commissioner on the Delhi Township Parks and Recreation Board. Pat was an avid reader and enjoyed crossword puzzles. He was a big sports fan and followed the Tigers and anything MSU, especially basketball and football. 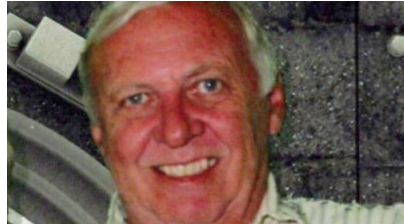
