



Dr. Phillip James Moore Sr.

Phillip James Moore Sr., 87 years old, passed away in the company of his wife and children at the Independence Village in Grand Ledge, Michigan on October 11, 2012. He was born August, 3, 1925 in Chicago, Illinois. He enlisted in the U.S. Navy V-12 program where they sent him to Princeton in 1943. He then interned in Wesley Memorial Hospital then started his residency until he was called back to active duty ending up as a naval doctor, stationed in Hawaii, where he met his bride, Ann Gibson. 1955 found the young Moore family in Owosso, Michigan where he became an Internal Medicine doctor and raised his family. He became well-known in Owosso and sat on many different boards throughout his long career. After he retired he became an avid genealogist tracing many of his and Ann's ancestors through detailed researching that often took him across many states and many countries, which culminated in publishing 3 genealogy books.

Phillip was known for his compassion and acceptance of people regardless of race, beliefs, gender or life choices; all people were equal in his eyes. He delighted many a person with his wonderful sense of humor. He also had many hobbies throughout his life, including his love for sailing, traveling, reading, and being a member of Owosso Rotary Club for many years. He is survived by his wife Ann (Gibson) Moore "The love of his life"; five children: Katherine (Moore) Godbold of Laingsburg, Michigan, Phillip Moore of Alma, Michigan, Helen (Moore) Longtin of Leander, Texas, Carol (Moore) Ralko of Canton, Michigan, and Edward Moore of Vail, Colorado as well as 5
