



## Richard John McCrackin

Richard John McCrackin, 79 of Grand Ledge, Michigan, passed away July 7th, 2021 at Sparrow Hospital surrounded by his loving family. He was born on October 3rd, 1941 in Carson City, Michigan to Richard and Margaret McCrackin. He married Carol Ann York on October 5, 1963 in Mt. Pleasant, Michigan. Dick graduated from St. Mary's High School in Carson City in 1959. He was in the United States Marine Reserve Corps for six years.

Dick graduated from the LCC/IBEW Local 665 electrical apprenticeship in 1965, where he was a member for 59 years. He was employed by Hatzel and Buehler in Lansing for 25 years.
