Ronald J. Hooson of Grand Ledge passed away August 2, 2015. He was born July 13, 1932 in Chicago to the late George J. and Cora M. (Richter) Hooson. Ron was a retired Chief Petty Officer with the United State Coast Guard and also worked in maintenance at Michigan State University after retirement. He believed in investing in young people and coached both football and baseball in Lansing for many years.
