Susanne May Rademacher, 89, of Grand Ledge, passed away on March 29, after a brief illness. During her last days she was surrounded by her family and comforted by their constant vigil.

Susanne was born on October 2, 1935, to Mark and Erma (Burman) Judson of Grand Ledge, and graduated from Grand Ledge High School in 1953. Though she was an only child, she gained 8 siblings (in-law) when she married Edward L. Rademacher on June 26, 1953 at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Pewamo, MI.

Sue was deeply supportive of her children's numerous activities and was also active in them. She was a : 4-H leader, a member of the St. Michael's Altar Society, member of the church choir, the RCIA program, organist for Sunday Masses, and a prayer partner at St. Michael's school, and Relay for Life.
