Timothy Coté of Grand Ledge passed away on September 24, 2021 after a courageous battle with cancer. Tim was born May 12, 1950 in Detroit, Michigan to Alfred and Elaine (McBurney) Coté. He attended Tecumseh High School and managed the Green Door in Lansing for many years. He was an employee at the Grand Ledge Recycling Center and chaired the Absentee Voter Board for the City of Grand Ledge. Tim was self-taught in technology and really enjoyed and focused on website design. He was a talented photographer and a collector of diecast cars. He also founded a website and community for diecast enthusiasts.
